## New contemporary art gallery in Makati opens with group show

AN independent, artist-led contemporary art gallery, creative space and art consultancy opened its doors in Makati last month with the aim to present local and international artists in an “engaging and inclusive manner to revolutionize the way art is communicated and interacted with.”

Located at Warehouse 20A La Fuerza 1 2241 along Don Chino Roces Avenue, Modeka offers a diverse and eclectic mix of artworks to provide experiential exhibitions. The new gallery also puts premium on site-specific art installations, artist development opportunities, and strategic art consultancy to connect artists with brands to create unique opportunities for collaboration and art-driven experiences, along with art curation services for brands and institution.

For its first show, Modeka gathered artists from different places and practices to take on the idea of fading luminescence, of impermanence, in the ongoing group exhibition, titled Nothing Gold Can Stay.

The show is on view until January 31. Nothing Gold Can Stay also showcases works by Indonesian artists Sinta Tantra, Dedy Sufriadi and Ronald Apriyan, along with that of Caryn Koh of Malaysia. Modeka is located at Warehouse 20A La Fuerza 1 2241, Don Chino Roces Avenue in Makati City. On view at the space until January 31 is its maiden exhibit No Gold Can Stay.
