Seolhaewon's 'Art Project' Synta Tantra murals, etc.

The works of world-famous art masters will be unveiled from the 23rd at 'Seolhaewon', a comprehensive resort located in Yangyang.

Seol Hae-won will unveil the new mural 'Pink Moon Rising, 2021' by Indonesian-British artist Sinta Tantra and six paintings based on it at the recently built golf clubhouse on the 14th, said.

Synta Tantra graduated from the Royal Academy, the best art school in the UK, and was invited to the 2012 London Olympics as a public artist for the Main Bridge in Carnery Wharf, London.

In this art project, Synta Tantra expressed the murals with motifs of the moon and stars surrounding Seorak Mountain in the space of Seolhaewon Golf House.

Seolhaewon said, "This project is designed to contribute to the development of local culture in Gangwon-do and to present a special artistic experience to customers who visit Seolhaewon."

Lee Ji-yoon (former director of the Seoul Pavilion at the National Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art), the CEO of Sum Project, who planned this project, said, "The mural to be unveiled this time was created by Lukasz Kornacki, a Polish craftsman of gold leaf art, who oversaw the decoration of Big Ben in London. I made the work of Tantra myself," he explained.
