In this exhibition, ISA Art & Design will showcase the work of a female artist from Bali, Sinta Tantra at the ISA Art & Design Gallery at Wisma 46, Sudirman, Jakarta.

Sinta Tantra herself is a Balinese female artist based in England and Indonesia.

Sinta is known for her colorful abstract paintings , as well as custom-made murals for a location.

Her popular works are in the form of murals in public spaces from Hong Kong to Liverpool.

One of her most eye-catching works is the mural that adorns the 300-meter bridge at Canary Wharf, London as part of the 2012 Olympic project.

In fact, recently Sinta has also completed a mural project that adorns the facade of Poins Square Mall and Apartments in South Jakarta.

Her compositions are quite balanced with works inspired by past art movements such as *Bauhaus, Art Deco, Abstract Expressionism* , and *Modernism* .

As for her style, Sinta admitted that she was more inspired by Nyoman Lempad and Sol LeWitt with their two- and three-dimensional lines.
