

Glauert, Rik, '13 Hong Kong art exhibitions not to miss this October', LifeStyle Asia, 5 October 2016

It is Hong Kong's first solo show of Tantra's vibrant geometric paintings, which explore dimensions through dramatic use of colour and shape. The exhibition is site-specific and blends with the gallery's space for a truly immersive experience.
